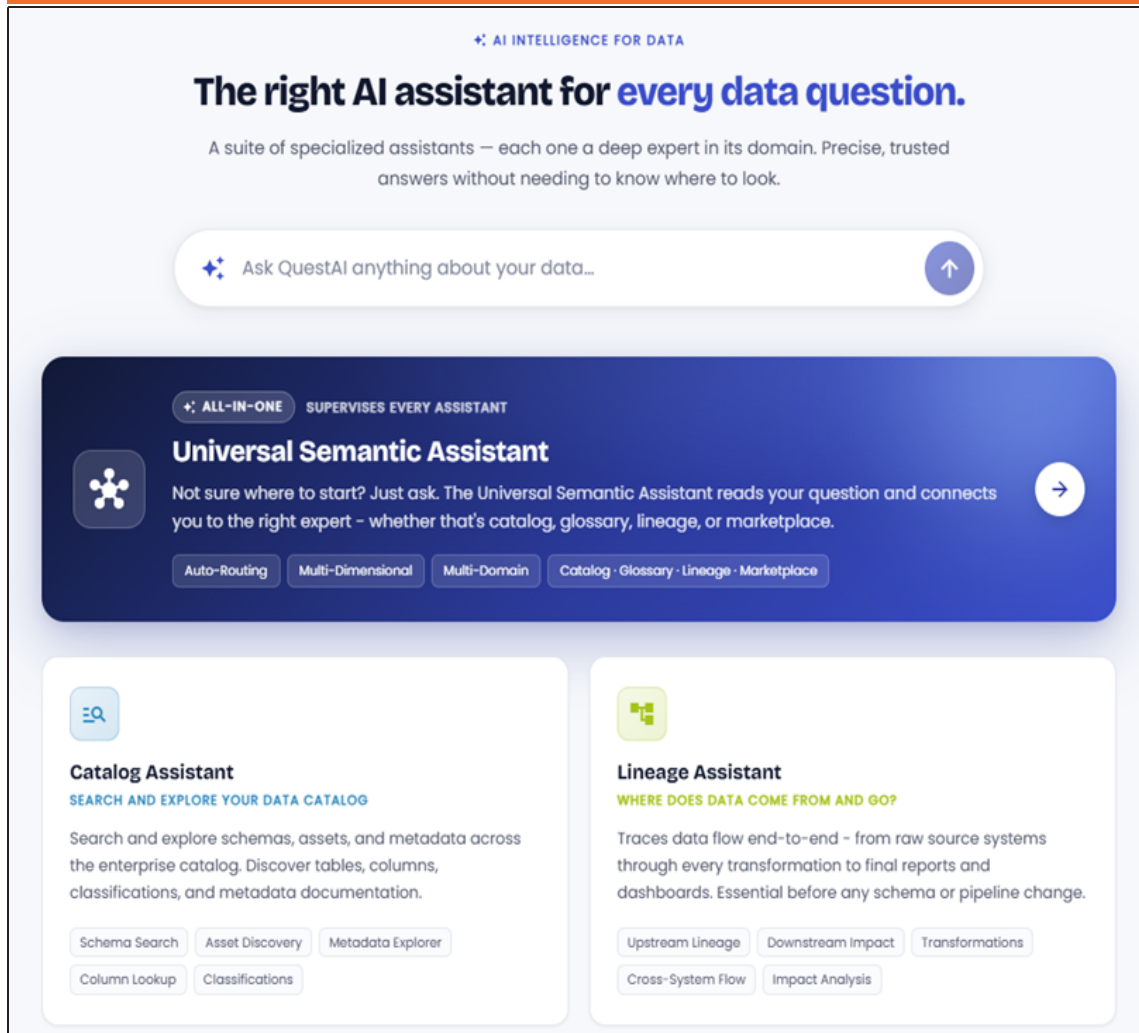
New Features

The following sections walk you through a brief description of the new features and wherever relevant, a reference to more information.

QuestAI

QuestAI is a centralized AI assistant hub that enables conversational access to enterprise data. It enables you to ask questions in natural language to discover assets, understand lineage, access glossary definitions, and perform stewardship tasks. If you are unsure which AI assistant to start with, the Universal Semantic Assistant intelligently routes queries across specialized assistants for catalog, lineage, glossary & ownership, marketplace, and stewardship, delivering accurate insights grounded in enterprise metadata.

QuestAI eliminates manual searches and documentation deep dives, making data governance accessible to every stakeholder, regardless of technical background.

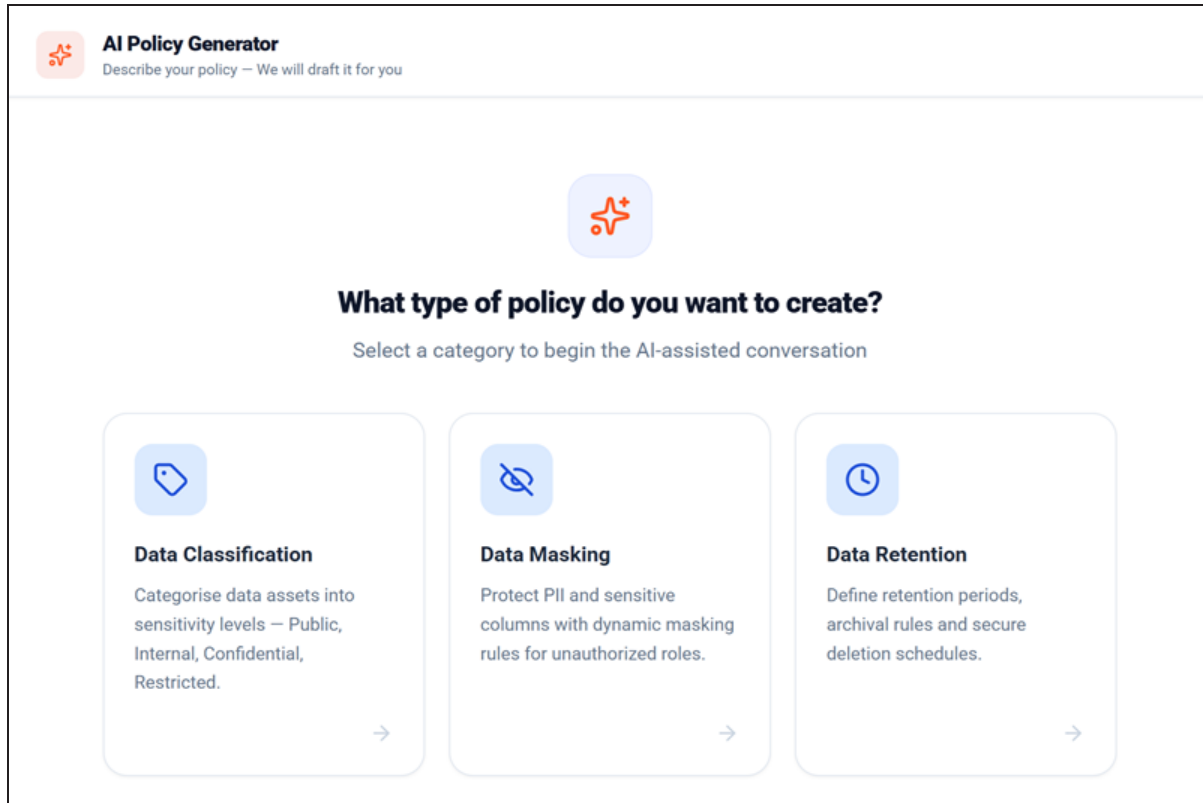

Policy Manager

Policy Manager is a new AI-driven module that enables you to efficiently create, manage, and enforce data governance policies.



Business users and data stewards can create policies using AI, automatically generate enforcement rules and SQL scripts, and operationalize policies across platforms. The module provides centralized views for policies and associated rules.

New Features and Enhancements

Enterprise Tag Groups

The Enterprise Tags module has been renamed to **Enterprise Tag Groups**, introducing governance-driven tagging capabilities that transform metadata organization from a flat, inconsistent model into a structured, controlled classification framework. This enables better consistency, control, and discoverability of metadata.
